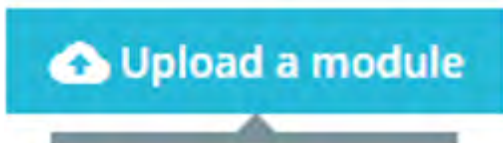
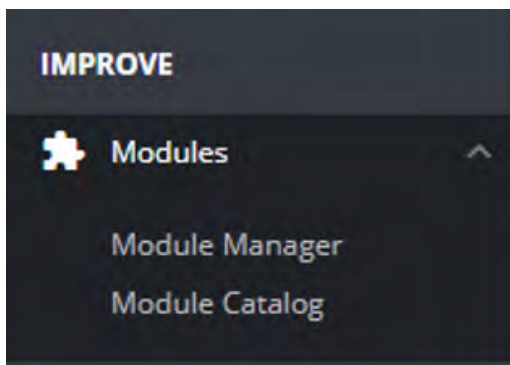


How to use open-source platform plugins with Swedbank Payment Initiation PrestaShop

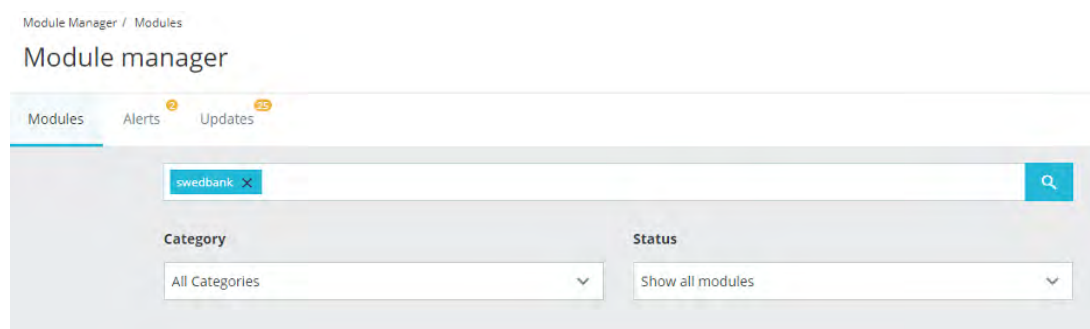
- 1 Download plugin from <http://sppdemoshop.eu/#banklink>
- 2 Click **Upload a module** to select the downloaded plugin for PrestaShop.



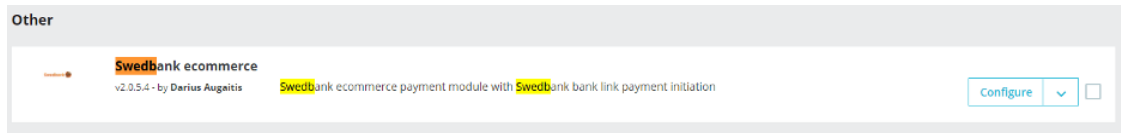
- 3 Find **Modules** in the menu of the left and select **Module Manager**.



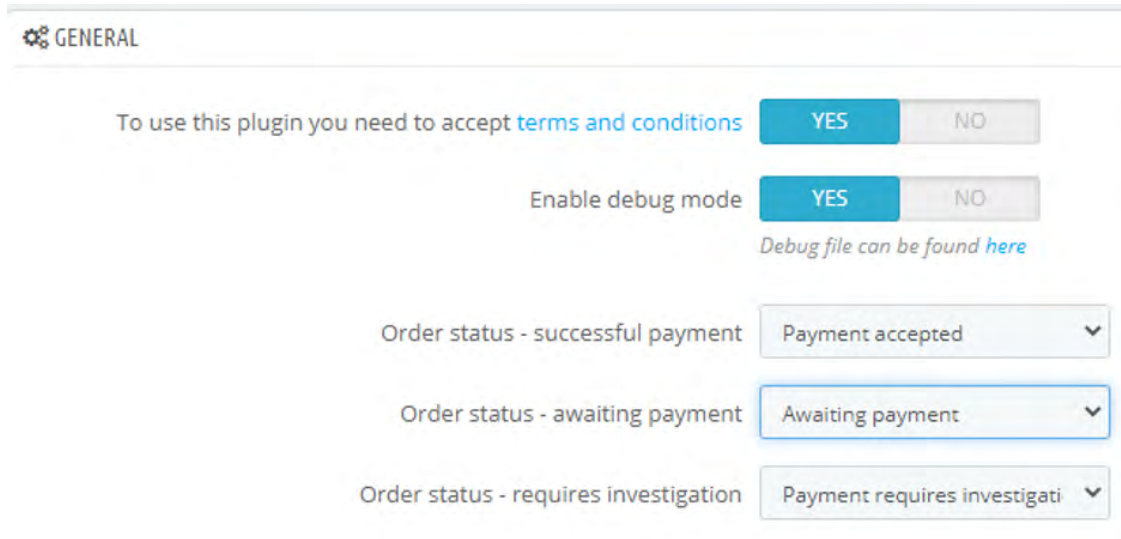
- 4 Type **Swedbank ecommerce** into the Extension search.



5 Click on **Configure**.

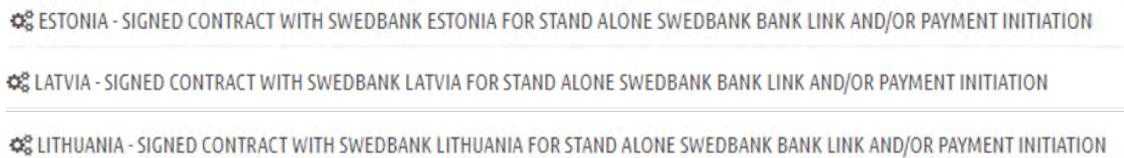


6 General settings

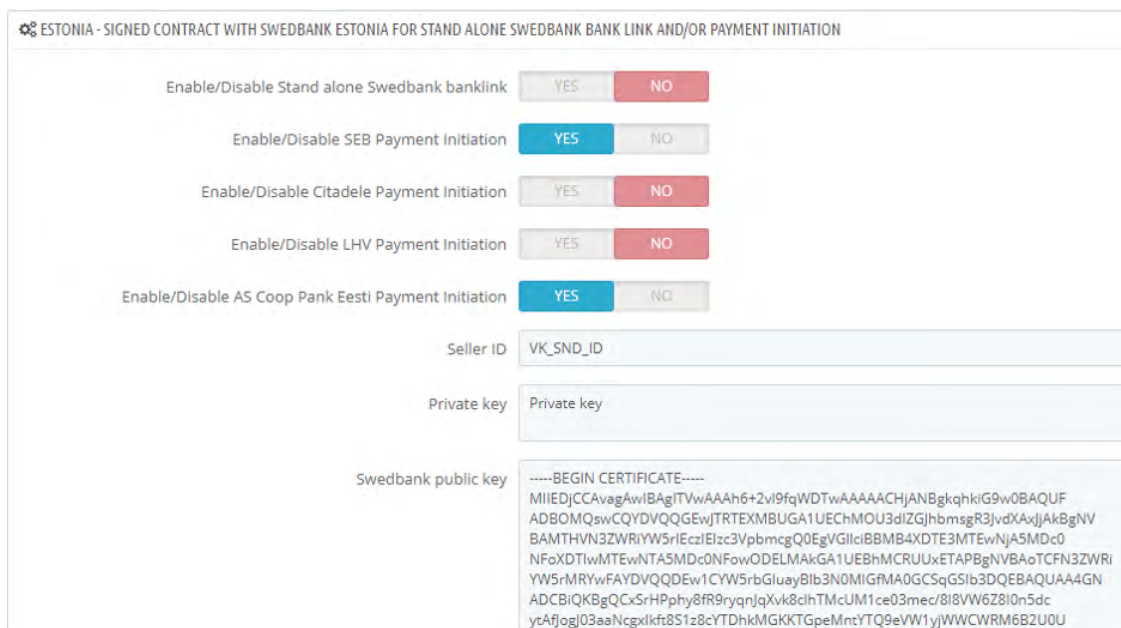


It is always recommended to set the **Enable debug mode** to **Yes**.

7 Scroll down to your country specific settings (example: I have an active contract for Payment Initiation in Estonia and so I only need to set the configurations in the "For Estonia" section).

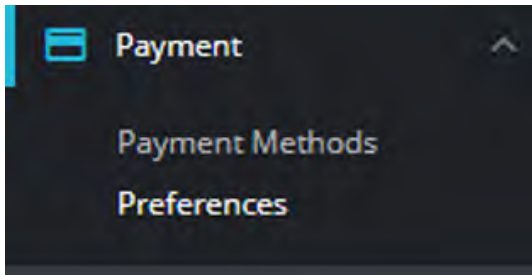


8 Enable the Payment methods you want to be available in your E-shop cart.



- ▶ Seller ID = VK_SND_ID (the Merchant ID provided by Swedbank).
- ▶ Private key (a certificate generated by the E-shop owner) If you already have a Regular Swedbank Bank Link then you can use the same Private key for initiating payments from other banks.
- ▶ The Swedbank Public key is already defined in the plugin – you don't need to change it.

9 Find **Payment > Preferences** in the menu on the left.



10 Tick the Swedbank ecommerce check box for the countries you want to start showing this payment type.
